From 2011 through 2013, Highland District Hospital partnered with the American Cancer Society to host this event, and HDH then continued the event beyond the years that the American Cancer Society participated. Although we have elected not to host Brake for Breakfast this year, we are still committed to breast health, and certainly urge all women to get their annual mammogram. In support of Breast Cancer awareness, we continue to partner throughout the year with the Highland County Health Department to provide no-cost digital screening mammograms, and also worked to secure and complete a grant to offer no-cost diagnostic mammograms to those who qualified.

Our mission now is to focus on preventative screenings for several cancer types and bring access for those screening opportunities to our community. To begin that charge, we incorporated reduced-cost Colorectal Cancer Screenings as a service available at our 2017 Health Fair. As we transition through 2018, we will continue to offer access to other types of free or reduced-cost cancer screenings to increase the number of people tested, and to help identify issues and diagnose more quickly.
